This year, we organized our annual camp at 'College Fleurs de Chou', a school located at Crois des Bouquets.










## Under a carefully chosen theme

For children 8 to 12 years, a very enthusiastic instructor led the session in such a way as to get their attention.


Teens are spread out in several different small groups; it was very participative study. The objective of the small groups is to allow others to ask questions

And Past. Azer said: Yes , it is possible with God's help




# Moral Education






### Gifts received from our supporters for the children
